Behavioral Use of reinforcement methods to change learners' behaviors
Cognitive Use of sensory input and reputation to change learners' pattern of thought thereby changing behaviors
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Critical Use of ongoing discussion and repetition to change learners' depth of knowledge, thereby changing thinking and behaviors
Developmental Use of techniques specific to learners' development stages to determine readiness to learn, and to impart knowledge
Humanistic Assists learners to grow by emphasizing emotions and relationships and believing that free choice will prompt actions that are in their own best interest
Social learning Links information to beliefs and values to change or shift the learners' expectations
