Pakistan's main share of textile products is more than 50% yarn only. Today Pakistan's textile industry is based on 60% on spinning sector, 22% on weaving sector, and 18% on the finishing sector. Share of the textile sector in Pakistan's economy, along with its contribution to exports, employment, foreign exchange earnings, investment and value added in industry, makes it the single largest determinant of the growth in the manufacturing sector.

It has 46% share in overall manufacturing activity, 68% share in export earnings with the value of \$7 billion. The value addition in this sector accounts for 9% of GDP and its share in the overall employment is 38%. Trends Textile industry is concentrating towards value added products which includes garments, finishing fabric, home textiles, towels, curtains, trousers, shirting, and designer knitwear.
