If left untreated nodes may permanently impact a voice. The best treatment is voice therapy from askilled vocal therapist. Vocal nodules can improve with resting your voice but if you go back to tramatizing your voice they could come back. If voice therapy isn't working then you might need them removed by a surgeon. The surgeon will probably tell you what notes you can't sing past.
