The question that asked candidates about qualities that commands respect in the classroom was full of insight. First, the personality of the person answering the question would be revealed. If "grades" were the answer, that reveals the person's belief in positive or negative reinforcement.

Another question that reveals the candidate's belief is the one that inquires about stating the goals of a school principal.
