On finances, asserts that understanding the budget poses a challenge since the budgets vary from one district to another. He claimed that the state might reduce the funds allocated to the schools. He also plans to open a preschool next year. He suggests that the school curriculum seems to be expanding. On technology, he noted that there are no limits on how far such can be in the school. However, he claimed that the district was perusing all the opportunities to introduce the children to technology.
