There are numerous things that concern me when it comes to grammar and writing. I am now suddenly very aware of it because of the many issues that we could have examined this week for our discussion. After evaluating the discussion topic, I really deliberated that the use of apostrophes and fragments was the topic that required to be looked at (Strunk, 2012).

The following is an example of two sentences in one of the paragraphs: “ This boat is Peter’s.” This was the first original sentences, and after reading and understanding from the website provided, the first sentence does not sound great (Strunk, 20120.
