33 leagues to the island of San Salvador
Letter to Luis de Santangel Regarding the First Voyage
notes that there are "people innumerable" on the islands & that he receives no opposition in claiming them for Spain
Letter to Luis de Santangel Regarding the First Voyage
focuses on beauty & wonder of Hispaniola (its majesty, fertility of land, harbors and coastline, birds, fruits, etc.)
Letter to Ferdinand and Isabella Regarding the Fourth Voyage
feels like he hasn't had the recognition he deserves for opening up South & Central America to the Spanish
Letter to Ferdinand and Isabella Regarding the Fourth Voyage
describes his actual travels on his voyage; spends time focusing on the bad fortune & equipment that left him stranded for nearly a year
Letter to Ferdinand and Isabella Regarding the Fourth Voyage
thinks that by giving them no problems and by allowing them to explore, it insults Columbus' honor and worsens the whole enterprise of exploration
