Simile: a figure of speech involving the comparison of one thing with another thing of a different kind, used to make a description more emphatic or vivid (e.

g. as brave as a lion.) 3) using sounds: using sounds make all kinds of target audience hook towards your writing. Use menacing sounds for example 4) Metaphors: a figure of speech in which a word or phrase is applied to an object or action to which it is not literally applicable. 5) time: Never hesitate to spend time on checking.
