The assault was led by the International Security Assistance Force (ISAF). 38 insurgents were killed while in the other two attacks on Saturday and Sunday in the south and north of Kabul, the capital city of Afghanistan. According to the Reuter, such assaults and counter attacks would weigh heavily during the review of the US President Barack Obama's Afghanistan war strategy due in December and on the NATO summit to be held next month in Lisbon.

In a news reported from Peshawar, the Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Ameer Haidar Khan Hoti repeated the commitment of his government for wiping off terrorism from the state and initiating the peace process.
