

How vyvanse works

One patient, in particular, Lori's eight-year-old daughter, is said to describe the medicine as a cardiac medication because it makes her heartbeat go fast. There may also be side-effects that may be caused when the drug is simultaneously taken with vitamins, supplements or medications. With the side-effects specified earlier, precaution must be taken by patients with heart problems, heart defects, high blood pressure, mental problems such as psychosis, tics or Tourette's Syndrome and seizures. The physician must be informed about the medical history of the patient to make sure there would be no adverse side-effects to the medication (fda. gov, 2012).
