This means trade receivables on goods delivered to them with regards to the credit policy of the company may not be paid, as unsecured debts have a lower priority than other debts during the liquidation process of a company. Hence, it will definitely affect the trade receivables balance brought forward. In theory, the amount should be credited in the trade receivables account and debited in the provision for bad debts account, and the difference should be reflected in trade receivable account, albeit with a note at the end.
