when you type a URL into the address bar and press the enter key, internet explorer automatically adds `http://` to the URL and then displays the page. If you are using the internet explorer app via a touch screen, you use the `swipe` gesture to move between recently viewed pages. You use the `tap` gesture to conduct a search using the default search site for internet explorer. When using the internet explorer app, if a page extends below the bottom of the screen, you point to the `bottom` of the screen to display a vertical scrollbar. Web pages are displayed on `tabs` in the internet explorer desktop application. When you pin a web page to the start screen, it appears `as a tile` to the right of the tiles already on the screen. A `bookmark` is a shortcut to a web page saved in a list in the internet explorer desktop application. By default, web pages are kept in internet explorer history for `20` days. When using the mail app, clicking the send button `moves` the message from your computer onto your email server. A red wavy line under a word you type in the message section of mail means `the word is not in the built-in spell checker`. You manually check for new incoming mail by `clicking the sync button on the apps bar`. If you receive an email message that includes multiple recipients, and you wish to respond back to the same list of recipients, use the `reply all` command. A happy face or sad face image placed in a message text of an email is called a(n) `emoticon`. An `attachment` is a file you send with an email message. The collected information about a contact in the people app is called a(n) `profile`.
