In 1757, he went to England to represent Pennsylvania in its fight with the descendants of the Pen family over who should represent the Colony. He remained in England to 1775, as a Colonial representative not only of Pennsylvania. In 1765, Franklin was caught by surprise by America's overwhelming opposition to the Stamp Act. His testimony before Parliament helped persuade the members to repeal the law. He started wondering if America should break free of England.
