Each lr tk turn to thrw 3 darts. The score is reduced by the sum of the darts thrown in each turn. Bullseye scores 50, the outer ring scores 25 and a dart in the double ring (triple in the diagram) scores double the value of the ring. The objective is to be the first to reduce the score to 0. This is, however, impossible if you throw the dart in a double or the bullseye. If a player reduces the score to 1 or goes below zero, the player is bust, the turn ends immediately and the score is returned to what it was at the start of the turn.

Let us take this example to explain the bust. If a player has 32 to go and the first dart is a 16, the second is a 15, the player is bust and the score is returned to 32. So in the last turn, it is not necessary to throw all 3 darts - a player can win with the first or second dart of the turn. A player who misses a targeted double is likely to play the single of that segment. Hence, good players often try to leave themselves with a number such as 24 or more than 32 - (double 16). Therefore, if a player has double 16 left, and hits a 16, he has double 8 left and if he then hits an 8, he has double 4 left and so on. This is done because the number of darts needed to be thrown in order to reduce the score to 0 is typically

litting the 11". This rule states that when the player is ready to start, in the first round, the player must "split the 11" by throwing a dart between the two numbers forming the number 11 on the board. This is a great trick in the game of darts.

180 is the highest score on a dartboard with three darts. This score is achieved by throwing three darts in the triple 20. When the player first decides who goes first, they should throw one dart at the board and whoever is closest to the bullseye first.

This game is often called "darts" and is known as "darts for the middle." A game of 501 can be won in just nine darts. This requires that the player throw three 180s (three triple 20s) in their first two turns, which is a score of 141. You might be amazed to find how easy it is to miss the dartboard if it is your first time playing the game.

While there is no right or wrong way to throwing darts, there are a few important rules you can follow to make sure you hit the board. • Always stand in the center of the target so you are trying to hit, and throw the darts from the level in front of the mark the dart flew to during the imaginary line from your feet to the board. • Do not flick the dart with your wrist when you throw it.

In the end, when you are playing the game, it is important to stay in a smooth fluid motion. The dart flies through the air quite easily, and will easily stick into the board. You don't have to be "Hulk" to throw them.

- Ensure you keep your balance by making sure both feet are on the ground.

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
