Your Task: Create a critical response to one of the 3 questions listed below. This is a formal essay, and therefore you will include an introduction, clearly developed ideas and arguments, and a conclusion. READER, CULTURE, and TEXT: If you select one of the questions below I am asking you to consider that a text's meaning is determined by the reader and by the cultural context. The interpretation of a text is dependent on various factors including: * The reader's cultural identity * Age * Gender * Social status * Historical and cultural setting of the text Question 1: How could the text be read and interpreted differently by two different readers? Question 2: If the text had been written in a different time or place or language, or for a different audience, how and why might it differ? POWER AND PRIVILEGE: If you select the question below I am asking you to think about how and why social groups are represented in this text in a particular way. In addition, consideration may be given to who is excluded from or marginalized in a text, or whose views are silenced.
