Assignments will be marked on the following criteria: -Ability to identify legal issues and cases that are relevant - Ability to apply these to practical situations and makes links between law and nursing -Assignment presentation - introducing the area of law, outlining the relevant legal principles and using case law in support of your discussion - Ability to summarise key factors Some pointers! â�' Open your essay with a short, clear statement about the topic on which you are writing — for example, ' Certain aspects of reproduction, such as contraception and abortion, have been the subject of much debate in Ireland, particularly from a legal perspective.' It can also be a good idea to open your essay with an important quotation, for example — a quote from a judge in a particularly important case on the area or from a text on reading list â�' Deal with definitions early! â�' Identify relevant law — for example, " In the area of mental health law, the principal piece of legislation is the Mental Health Act 2001" \hat{a} $\hat{\phi}$ Identify relevant case law - facts of cases are relevant however do not dwell

on these as they are already known to the reader! — more important is the point of law to be derived from a case — i. e., the decision — did this decision change the law? Is this regarded as a 'good' decision? Has this judgment been heavily criticised? (some cases will obviously be more important than others!) â�' Be critical! - THIS WILL REQUIRE EXTRA READING— failures and successes of the law!!! — Argue as a nurse â�' Conclusion — you may use the conclusion to summarise your main points — what is your opinion? — What could the law do in the future to make it easier for people in your position? Etc... And finally.... â�' Please italicise case names — for example, McGee v. Attorney General [1974], Attorney General v. X [1992] â�' Quotes, comments, ideas etc utilised - directly or indirectly — must be referenced — basically any idea that is not your own must be referenced!
