Part II: Purpose and Feature of Story

There are several types of feature stories. These are; profile, explanatory piece, colour story, human interest, news feature, backgrounder, lifestyle feature, travel story, general feature, interview piece, investigative feature, column and review (Helitzer 162). The type of feature-focused in the article is the Human interest story. The article focuses on interactions between a professional, a coach, basketball team and the Rutgers community. The emotion created in the story is of remorse, derived from the way the coach relates with his team. The use of slur and humiliating approaches to team members who possess talent and vigour in the game is demoralizing.
