 conflict A struggle between characters or an event that causes concern
 exposition Information about the setting and characters
 fact Something that can be proven
 falling action The events that occur after the climax
 inference Looking beyond what is obvious; take what you know and clues from the text, put it together and draw an... opinion
 What someone thinks
 plot A sequence of related events in a story
 point of view The angle from which a story is told
 resolution The outcome of the plot or how things are settled in the end
 setting Where and when a story takes place
 simile A comparison between two unlike things, using like or as
 symbol A person, place, or object that has another meaning beyond the obvious (for example, a rose)
 theme The main idea or most important idea in a story
 ammunition Things that can be fired from a weapon. Spire a top or pointed part of something; a tall, sharp-pointed part. Point that tapers upward, as on a church.
